





NEW GAP PASTOR

The board of directors has been working closely with the MCC Office of Church Life and Health and is pleased to announce the appointment of Rev. Elder Don Eastman as the Gap Pastor for Founders MCC. Rev. Elder Eastman will be with us starting July 7th through September 8th. He brings a wealth of knowledge and experience, including serving on the board of Elders from 1983 until 2007. As a dedicated student of church life and growth, Rev. Eastman has been one of MCC's most passionate advocates for ministry excellence in local churches. In 1995, he created the Strategic Growth Initiative, which developed Benchmarks of Excellence in Ministry and provided training programs, consultation services and other resources to support thousands of local leaders in building healthier churches. Rev. Elder Eastman was also a member of MCC Los Angeles from 1986 to 2005; and in January-February 1997 led MCC LA in the Strategic Growth Initiative consultation process following which the average annual worship attendance grew from 190 in 1996 to 240 in 1997 and 280 in 1998.
