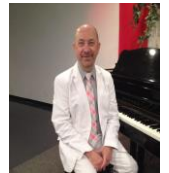




Seen Jesus Lately?

I hope this finds you all still healthy and safe. Last Sunday, we had such a wonderful service, and I am so thankful to have such a great team to keep things moving - keeping the Church ALIVE - even during this pandemic.

There is a lot of speculation out there about when we will be able to re-open stores, churches, schools, etc. The answer is simple: when we feel it is safe to do so! Our Board of Directors met this week, and we agreed that we will follow the guidelines set up by the CDC and our state and local leaders. We will continue to work behind the scenes to be ready when we have the green-light to open, but we want to be sure that we are doing everything possible to keep people from becoming sick.

Yes, it's the day we recognize Jesus ascending into the clouds after telling the disciples He would send another Comforter - the Holy Spirit - to be with us to the end of time. 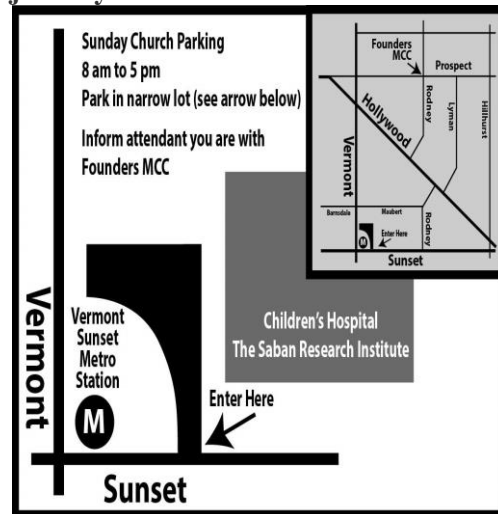
