



## ***“Freedom, Even When Surrounded by Evil”***

**Dear Saints,**

**06-22-2025**

Last week, there was a mix-up in my message to you - you received the Spanish version, rather than the English version. I want to reiterate some of the points I made, as there are people who must be recognized and important information you may have missed.

What a whirlwind of emotions we have experienced so far this month. We've had such amazing, combined worship services, with the last one having a drama presented by **Rev. Eric Buter** (who acted along with **Niki Mohr**, **Omar Oyanguren** and **Kevin Carter**). It was so powerful! Thank you to all of you involved in this presentation!

We marched in the original **LA Pride Parade** (started in 1970 by our own church's founder, **Rev. Troy Perry** and two other community leaders) and had a booth at the **LA Pride Festival**. There were 36 volunteers that marched, staffed our booth, or waited at the church (in case someone showed up for worship). Seven people even received Communion at our Pride Booth! Thank you to ALL of you!

There were thousands of us in Hollywood celebrating Pride two weeks ago, and just a couple of miles away, there were people being arrested or detained by ICE and Homeland Security. We have seen a major escalation of this, with ICE and Homeland Security even coming into churches. **We will need more volunteers in the coming weeks for the White Wall at the 1:30 p.m. service.** Guarding our church gate is an act of WORSHIP and an act of RESISTANCE to unfair treatment. I want our people of color to know that the rest of us are WITH you and will continue to SUPPORT you.

I'm so thankful for our members who are willing to go and represent those who can't go. **Pastor Lucia Chappelle** and I attended a powerful Interfaith Prayer Vigil in downtown LA where **Mayor Karen Bass** joined a host of others in prayer for our city and our country. Many of us have been out in the streets on other days, including last Saturday's **No Kings Day**.

Last weekend, we celebrated **Trans Pride**, **Juneteenth**, and **Father's Day**. On Saturday, our Trans\*Unity Ministry was out in full force! (Three folks received Communion there!) We had a special treat on Sunday, too: **Student Clergy Bam Noriega** preached for us! His message was entitled, *More Than Just The Binary*. Thanks, Bam, for a very enlightening message!

This Sunday, I will be back in the pulpit with a message entitled, *Freedom, Even When Surrounded By Evil*. If you'd like to read ahead, check out Luke 8:26-29, 37-39 (Voice Version).

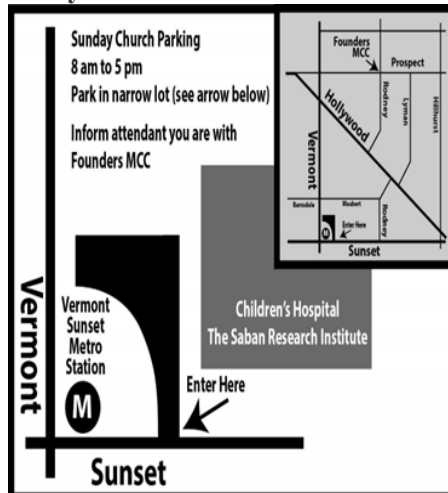
