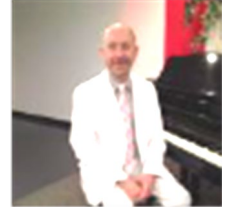




“Out of the Tomb, Into the Streets”

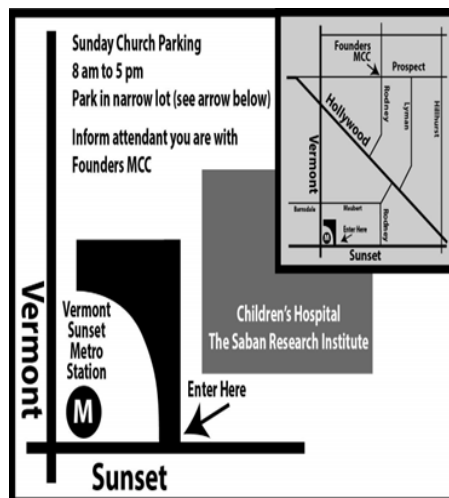
