Last Sunday we welcomed Raul Radilla as our Pastoral Leader for our Latino congregation. Congratulations and welcome, Raul!

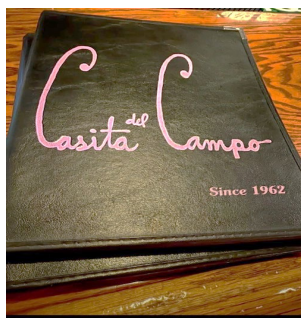

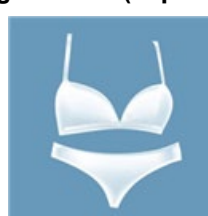


CHURCH OUTSIDE THE WALLS

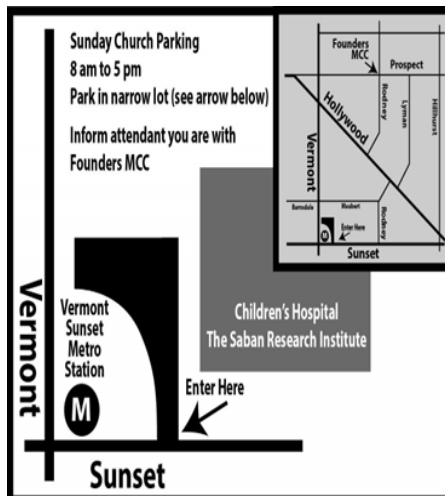
